World class & welcoming

North Mayfair is a treasure trove of delights. Fast becoming a neighbourhood lauded for the variety of dining options available, it is growing an enviable reputation as a top foodie destination, receiving high praise from commuters, shoppers, visitors and residents.

A thriving mixed residential and commercial neighbourhood of interlocking streets, the area links with the bustling energy of Oxford Street one of the busiest shopping streets in Europe, and brings in the Selfridges shopper looking for an enhanced experienced within an oasis of calm.

Connectivity is one of North Mayfair's most defining characteristics. With Bond Street and Marble Arch stations nearby, North Mayfair will also benefit hugely from the forthcoming Elizabeth Line Bond Street Crossrail station, situated at Weighhouse Street, with nearby Crossrail interchanges at both Bond Street and Tottenham Court Road. The arrival of Crossrail will bring, it is estimated another 1.5 million people within a 45 minute journey of the West End* and is forecast to increase retail spend in the area by £1.4 billion once the line is open.**

The centerpiece is Grosvenor Square, which leads directly into North Audley Street and Duke Street. Originally created as an homage to the 'countryside in the city', the square is set to become the preeminent green space in the West End when it is handed over to the developers in 2023 to create a world class city centre garden destination.

Brown Hart Gardens is a distinct raised terraced garden, close to the famous Beaumont Hotel. The space was built in 1906 above the old Duke Street substation and is now a unique garden area with seating and a café - a magical retreat in the heart of the city.

The area has been bolstered in recent years with the addition of new dining and wellbeing offerings with the volume of new openings accelerating in 2022:

Apricity, a wonderful new restaurant on Duke St from the lauded chef Chantelle Nicholson with sustainability at the core of its purpose.

In addition, Bibi's from the renowned restaurant group JKS Restaurants and Ivy Asia have both opened on North Audley St this year.

The more established Mercato Mayfair on North Audley Street offers a continental style food market experience housed in St Mark's Church, a Grade 1 listed building. Comptoir Café & Wine a café by day and wine bar by night founded by Master Sommelier Xavier Rousset.

Lifestyle experiences come courtesy of establishments like Duck & Dry, an hair and nail salon and JAB, a fitness offering, both situated on North Audley Street.

A mixed residential and commercial neighbourhood, North Mayfair is a world-class destination with a local community feel, where traditional and contemporary sit comfortably, side by side.

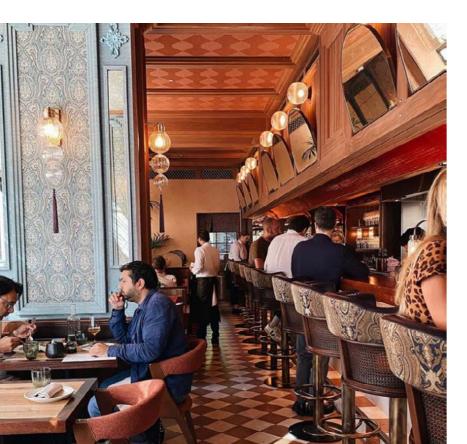

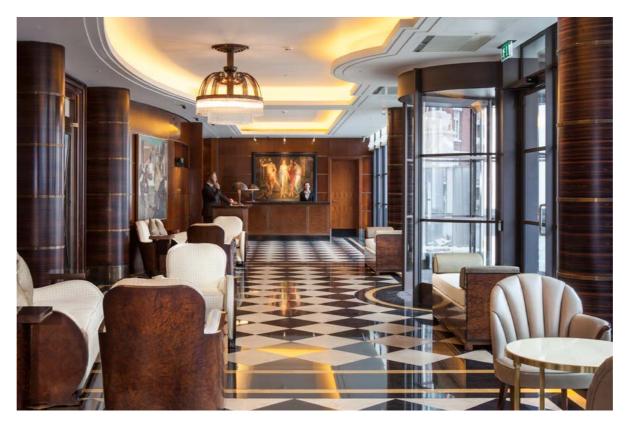

Inspired by the Art Deco hotels of the 1920's, The Beaumont is a five star hotel in a quiet garden square. The listed building is infused with art, with all public areas filled with original pieces and antiques. The hotel has just 50 rooms and 10 suites, with a unique suite – ROOM - holding a giant semi-abstract sculpture by artist, Anthony Gormley OBE. With the glamourous Colony Room restaurant and chic American Bar, The Beaumont Hotel really is one of a kind.

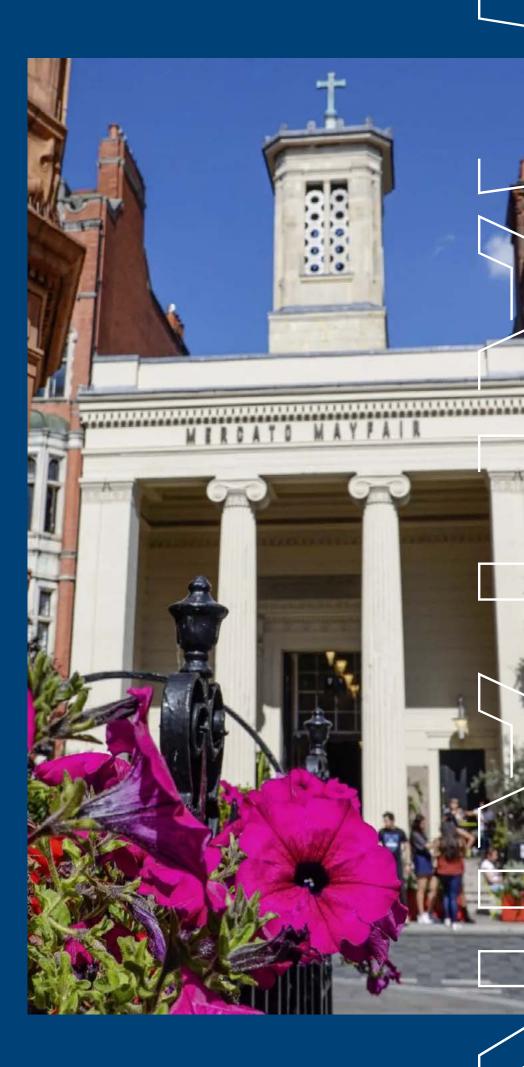
